EPISCOPAL PARISH ENTERS BIBLE STUDY PERIOD.

Local Rector Giving Interesting Series of Expositions on Epistles.

The Sunday school of St. Peter's parish is divided into five classes. The first two are studying the history of Christian missions beginning with the Great Commission to go out and evangelize the world. This course centers around the great missionary leaders of the Church, Jesus Christ being the chief and pattern missionary. The other classes are studying bible stories, illustrating the love of God and Creator and Father.

At the morning services, instead of a regular sermon, the rector is now giving a series of expositions on St. Paul's epistle to the Romans. The bible is not read and studied as it should be, and every pastor is painfully aware that the majority of his parishioners, especially the younger ones, have but a very scant knowledge of its contents. It is also increasingly difficult to get them to join a bible class and study with any sort of seriousness. The bible is not a magical charm which will work independent of human co-operation. It is necessary to read, mark, learn and inwardly digest it in order to obtain beneficial results. The rector hopes he may be able to arouse the interest of his hearers in the study so that they will be induced to search the scriptures for themselves and find out that therein are contained the words of eternal life.

St. Peter's guild after a well earned vacation, has started up its activities with already gratifying and encouraging returns. It hopes soon to clear Honan hall of its last dollar of indebtedness, of which a comparatively small balance remains to be defrayed.

Ladies to Study Politics.
In order that the ladies of Wallowa may have a better understanding of things political, and that they may be better equipped to apply their right of suffrage recently given to women of Oregon, the Ladies' Progressive club has arranged for a series of lessons and a course of study, and all women of the city are invited to take part in the work of study. Mrs. J. C. Baid, president of the club, gives the following explanation:

Oregon women now have the opportunity to aid in solving the problems of city, state and nation and it is important that they acquire a better knowledge of the laws of the society in which they live.

Whether we believe in the exercise of the ballot or not, we are all united in desiring a better environment for the race. Nothing can be accomplished by haphazard, ill directed efforts. We must not only know what we want but how to get it. This knowledge can be gained only by earnest conscientious study on the part of each individual.

For the benefit of those women who wish to cast their ballot, but would like to have a better understanding of current issues, the state library sends out a set of books on the science of government. The work is outlined to cover a year's study, beginning with the city charter.—Wallowa Sun.
