Dr. Sears spoke on X-ray Diagnosis and Dr. Hodges on Pelagra, the new disease, which, while prevalent in the eastern states and other countries, on the Pacific coast except in isolated cases. Both gentlemen showed thorough knowledge of their subjects, imparted much valuable information and their presence at the meeting was much appreciated.
