FIREMEN AT PENDLETON WAR

VOLUNTEERS SAID TO INTERFERE WITH AUTO CAR.

Paid Department Does Not Live at Station—Troubles Are Many.

Pendleton, Oct. 16.—There is dissension in the ranks of the Pendleton fire department and this state of affairs caused an eruption at the meeting of the city council last evening. It seems that the appointment of three paid men since the delivery of the auto chemical wagon has aroused jealousies and factional feeling among some of the firemen and councilman John Dyer openly declared in meeting last evening that several of the volunteer firemen did all in their power to interfere with Cliff Bellinger, driver of the auto truck, in the recent New Grand hotel fire.

Mr. Dyer declared he was present at the fire and secured his knowledge from personal observation. He stated that Bellinger did all in his power to get his chemicals in action early but was hindered in a number of ways by several of the volunteers.

The outcome of the situation may be the disbanding of the three central companies and the reorganization of a new one from a few of the best firemen from each. A meeting of the fire committee and the board of firemen will be held Tuesday evening to talk over the situation.

Chairman Ell of the fire committee, declared the trouble had arisen from misunderstandings and predicted that the Tuesday conference would restore harmony. It is said the dissension arose over the many applications for the three paid positions and the different claims put forward for each. Two of the positions are yet open and a new applicant, J. D. Sullivan, appeared last evening with a petition signed by a number of well known citizens.

The fire department of the city last evening was responsible for another argument. Having decided two weeks ago to place \$2,500 insurance upon the fire truck, the council last evening raised the amount to \$4,500 after a hot argument and a standing vote. The fire committee reported that the premium on the larger amount would be \$2.25 a hundred and that on the smaller amount it would be \$3.00. Councilman Dyer led the fight for \$4,500 and Councilman Cole for \$2,500. Mayor Matlock held out for no insurance at all, declaring the rate to be too high for the risk. Only five firemen were present and Ell and Siebert voting with Dyer, the \$4,500 policy was ordered.

The length of time required for the auto truck to reach the McConnell fire in the western part of the city several weeks ago caused Councilman Dyer to criticize the driver and resulted in an order for the installation of beds in the city hall so the driver and his assistants can sleep there instead of at their homes.
