

PEAR SEASON CLOSES WITH SUBSTANTIAL PRICES GIVEN

Portland, Ore., Oct. 30.—Special.—The pear season has wound up for the year in very satisfactory shape according to F. W. Gwin, head of the selling forces of the Northwestern Fruit Exchange.

In fact the season for Bosc has closed amid rather unusual excitement and rather extreme prices. The local exchange reports the last of its offering of Bosc sold on the New York market at an average of \$1.92 for half boxes and \$3.30 for boxes. This is an unusual price considering the recent standing of the pear trade and the overloaded condition of the trade prior to this time.

The exchange reports the sale of its last three cars of Comice pears in New York with the market standing firmer than for some time.

There is an improved feeling in the apple market and the outlook for the immediate future is exceedingly good, unless there is an over-abundance of offerings.

Several sales were reported by local interests from \$1.75 upward for Extra Fancy Spitzenburgs and \$1.80 for Yellow Newtowns. The situation is far the best in that section lying closer to the Rocky mountains than to the Atlantic seaboard. This is probably due to the fact that Atlantic seaboard cities have been heavy purchasers of Pacific Northwest apples for some time, therefore the immediate wants

of the trade are quite well taken care of.

No new developments are shown in the apple situation abroad. Receipts are increasing and naturally this has had the effect of keeping prices from seeking a higher level. Europe was a very heavy purchaser of Pacific Coast apples at the start of the season and these shipments are just beginning to appear in the markets here.
