BIG GAME AT PENDLETON SEES FRIENDS AS COACHES.

Light Line Will Probably Have Difficulty In Keeping Intact.

Tomorrow morning the La Grande football team leaves for Pendleton and will return tomorrow evening on No. 18. The game will be called at 2:00 o'clock in order to allow the team to come back the same day and in order to get all the sleep and rest possible in preparation for the big game with Baker here next week, no night traveling will be indulged in. The Pendleton team has an average line of 150 pounds and if they are fast and are able to handle the ball, should defeat the La Grande squad as the latter will not be able to overcome an extra weight of 10 pounds to the man, likely. The locals have been practicing with one thing in mind during the past week—speed and forward passes. To some extent they have accomplished this although they are far from being perfect.

Captain Couch has been playing in the back field all week and he will do the signal calling tomorrow. His ankle is still weak and he has not obtained the best speed yet.

Rosenbaum has earned a regular berth on the first squad because of his ability to pass the ball and to tackle. He is light but will be a good addition if he plays as he did last Saturday. This leaves Oliver at the other fullback position and Hunter and Proctor to fight out the other halfback. Winters and Garrity will be in the line-up and will make a great difference. Winters is a mighty valuable man on defense as Garrity is used on the end of most of the forward passes.

Last year the local team defeated the La Grande eleven at La Grande by a good big margin but several of the stars of that team are missing this year. La Grande was defeated last Saturday by Wallowa in a hard battle but that does not mean that her team is weak for the Wallowa bunch is admittedly strong. Coach Reynolds is counting on a victory here but so is Coach Asbahr. A tie game wont satisfy either.

Ulsters Own War Craft.

Dublin, Oct. 30.—It was admitted here today that an aeroplane corps has been organized by the "war department" of the "Ulster Provisional Government." Sir Edward Carson, one of the leaders of the militant anti-Home Rule Ulsterites, has received offers from half a dozen English aviators, the latest being B. C. Hucks, who recently assisted in the campaign of the Unionist candidate in the Midlothian by flying around over the district and distributing pamphlets from the sky. Ulsterites declare the aviation corps will be used merely to distribute propaganda against Home rule, but Home rule advocates declare the flying machines will be used in case of the promised and threatened conflict when the first Irish parliament is organized.

German Pensions Heavy.

Berlin, Oct. 30.—The enormous sum of 43,000,000 was paid out in old age

pensions and widow's pensions last year by the government insurance department, according to the reports for 1912 published today. The income fees under the old age pension together with what the government adds thereto, amounted to \$61,000,000. Interesting is the item of \$2,000,500 paid out to "brides" for "bridal equipment" and "doweries" upon marriage. Maternity insurance has also been added. The government insurance today possesses approximately one-one hundred and fiftieth part of the national wealth or in round figures \$500,000,000.
