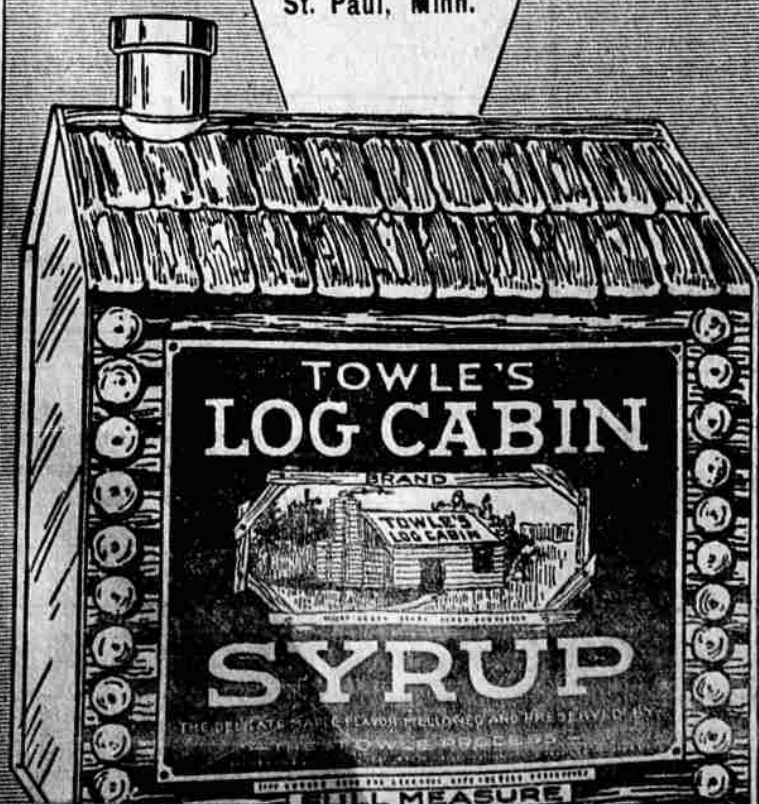

PORTLAND DEALERS FIND PLENTY OFFERINGS

No Changes in Chicken and Other Poultry Prices This Week

Receipts of poultry were very heavy in Portland this week, and as a result prices were unchanged. Small hens are bringing around 14½ cents and large, heavy birds from 15 to 15½c in Portland. Springers still hover around 14½c. Geese and ducks are unchanged. Live turkeys are 21c at most places, while dressed turkeys are 25c. Some extra fine ones have brought 26½c. The demand for turkeys should be very heavy from now on, both in Portland and in La Grande.
