BAKER CASE INTERESTS.

Baker, Dec. 6.—An interesting case involving the possession of a homestead near Sparta, was argued before Justice of the Peace Hubbard by Attorneys Charles F. Hyde and C. A. Moore of this city and Attorney Eberhard of La Grande, representing respectively Emil Diernfield and Albert Peterson, the litigants.

According to the facts presented yesterday, Diernfield occupied the land for a number of years after entry had been made by Leslie Bartho, who did not prove up the claim. At the expiration of the time in which proof might be made Peterson filed on the land and took up his residence there, he and his family and Diernfield living as neighbors, and both claiming the property.

Diernfield, it is said, has improved the property and brought a considerable portion of it under cultivation, but Peterson has stated that believing the law on his side he will stay in the fight to the very end to prove his claims.
