FOODSTUFFS ARE ON DECLINE

WHEAT TAKES AN APPARENT DOWNWARD COURSE

Western Egg Market Shows Signs of Falling Off.

There has been an easing in all of the commodities of life on the coast with wheat and meats on the downward slide. This is taken as an indication that the cost of living will in the near future, take a downward slide and remain on a lower level. The egg market of the coast has taken a slump through the arrival of larger numbers of eggs and the butter market is showing signs of weakening. Chicago, alone of all of the principal wheat buying districts showed an advance for this staple of life.

Fruit and Vegetables Cheaper. The Portland wholesale merchants declare the prices of greenstuffs will fall owing to the supply from California gardens. It is not thought, however, that this will affect the market here very much, owing to the distance which much of this foodstuff has to be shipped and the attending loss.
