FRED B. CURREY SUPPORTS A FORMER LA GRANDER.

San Leander Standard Carries Hearty Endorsement For Candidate.

Mr. Murphy has a large number of friends in La Grande who will be interested in the campaign, and appended is an article from the San Leander Standard, which is of double interest locally in view of the fact that the writer is Fred B. Currey old time La Grander, now editing a paper in the California town. The article says:

James M. Murphy, of Sacramento, has this week announced himself a candidate for the office of Secretary of State as a Progressive.
