"GO TO CHURCH" SUNDAY, PLAN

Pendleton, Jan. 27.—(Special).—A "go to church Sunday" observance has been named by the protestant ministers of this city, and the date set for next Sunday, February 1. This plan is a carrying out of the movement launched in Chicago some

weeks ago, the idea being to have at least one Sunday in the year an occasion when everybody will visit his respective church and it is the hope that in time the movement will become a national event and as well recognized as Christmas. It will be

essentially a church holiday when persons of all nationalities and creeds as well as those who have no special church affiliation will be expected to take part in the church observances.

The question was discussed at a meeting this morning of the local ministerial association, and from the pulpits of the Presbyterian, Baptist Methodist and Christian churches yesterday the respective pastors referred to it and urged that their congregations spread the news so that as many as possible will be aware of the efforts being made to get large attendances on that day. The businessmen will be asked by the ministers to arrange it so that any of their employes who may have work to do Sunday will be enabled to attend services.

The movement is not limited to the protestant churches but people of all other denominations have been asked to join in the endeavor to have a "go to church" day apart from the regular duties that fall upon the Sabbath.
