UNION ACTORS MAKE HIT

UNION CROWD SEES JAPANESE OPERETTA.

Amateur Actors Get Away With a Pleasing Performance.

Union, Jan. 30.—The citizens of the City of Union were treated to one of the best if not the best home talent play ever rendered in the city last Monday night when the Japanese operetta, the Princess Chrysanthemum, was put on at the Cozy theatre under the direction of Mrs. R. J. Kitchen, of this city.

The house was crowded and extra seats had been added to the regular opera chairs and practically all the extra space was taken before the curtain rose.

The play was given by the DeKoven Glee club, organized by Mrs. Kitchen last fall, and this was the initial appearance for the club before the footlights. In addition to the regular members of the club there were several assistants and the whole number of participants, about 35 in all, were roundly cheered as the curtain rose.

The costumes of the leading members of the play were certainly beautiful, those of the male members being imported, while all the choruses were dressed in gorgeous Japanese costumes. The dance of the Sprites and the umbrella dances were most artistic and showed great training and skill.

The plot of the playlet is set in a Japanese garden and centers around the marriage of the Emperor's daughter to Prince So Tru. The decorations of the stage was most artistic and in keeping with the costumes worn for the occasion.

The choruses throughout the operetta were rendered in a manner that showed ability in all those taking part and skill in training and the solo parts of all brought for the greatest applause from the highly pleased audience.

Between acts a vote was taken on the most popular young lady in the city of Union and the prize was awarded to Miss Elenor Hall who acted the principal part in the operetta.

The public were so pleased with the production that there is a strong demand for the same to be repeated. The proceeds go to the public library and will be the means of adding more books to this institution.
