ELGIN LAWYER'S FRIENDS ARE
BOOMING HIM LOUDLY.

Commissionership. Thinks Elgin, Is
Rightfully Their Share.

Attorney L. Denham of Elgin, is being groomed for the county representative job. While it was not generally known, Denham's friends had him talked up to run for the position at the last election, but with two already in the field, the Elgin people decided he had best not announce his intentions, but this year his friends are at him early. A group of Elgin people are in the city today on court matters and politics is the principal theme of discussion. The claim that Denham will very likely decide to run and that if he does, the announcement will be made shortly.

Want County Commissionership.

The Elgin delegation is confident the rest of the county will concede a county commissionership to Elgin. Cecil Galloway, the retiring commissioner, is an Elgin man but he doesn't want the job. Quietly, the Elgin people are coming their section for a man who could win. If no one else will take the job, Galloway may yet be persuaded to run for re-election. "It is mete and just that Elgin should have a commissioner," said the spokesman of the Elgin crowd today. "La Grande is entitled to the county judge, Union to a commissioner and Elgin to a commissioner."

NOTICE is hereby given that the assessment for the improvement of Section No. 4 of Sewer district No. 1, of the city of La Grande, Oregon, under the provisions of Ordinance No. 764, Series 1914, entitled "An Ordinance declaring the cost of constructing an 8-inch lateral sanitary sewer in section No. 4 of district No. 1, along the center line of the blocks lying between Walnut street and Alder street, from the center line of Jefferson avenue to the center line of "O" avenue, and along the center line of the blocks between "O" avenue and Walnut street from the center of Pennsylvania avenue to the center line of "O" avenue and along the center line of the blocks lying between Cedar street and Oak street from the center line of Spring avenue to the center line of "O" avenue and along the center line of the blocks between First street and Cedar street from the center line of Spring avenue to the North property line of Pennsylvania avenue; determining the property benefitted thereby, levying an assessment thereon to defray the costs and expenses of said improvement; providing for an assessment roll for the same, and directing the entry of said assessment roll in the docket of city liens; providing a time when the same shall become delinquent, and requiring the city recorder to prepare a special assessment roll in accordance with the assessments levied herein and to collect thereon—Spa hhh herein, and to collect such assessments, the same being the improvement of section No. 4 of sewer district No. 1, in said city of La Grande, Oregon, is now in my hands for collection and the same may be paid to me at any time within (10) ten days from the 4th day of February, 1914, without penalty, interest or cost; and each property owner is hereby notified that on application to the undersigned within (10) ten days from the 4th day of February, 1914, which is the first date of the publication of this notice, they will be allowed to pay such assessment in ten (10) annual installments, the first installment thereon being due and payable on or before the 14th day of January, 1915.
