

EXHIBIT HALL PLEADED FOR

ASHLAND HELD TO BE DESIR-
ABLE LOCATION.

Promoters For Ashland Exhibit Hall
Send Out Detail Plans.

Explanation in regard to the state exhibit building as proposed by the Oregon Development League, have been sent to La Grande. The promoters say:

"This matter is of vital interest to every section of Oregon if the people in the various sections of the state take the matter up at once and act upon it. The proposition is this—Tom Richardson, the great Oregon booster, is working the state now, and the people of Ashland are backing him up in this work, to get the state legislature to make an appropriation to put a state exhibit building at Ashland, Oregon, in which every county of the state will have an exhibit of their products and resources on display during the Fair at San Francisco in 1915.

"This is a wonderful opportunity for the state of Oregon to do cheap and effective advertising during that year.

"The reason for putting the exhibit building at Ashland is this: Ashland is a railroad division point, and every train will stop here long enough for the passengers to get off the train and see all the exhibits from the various counties of the state, and see what a wonderful state Oregon is, how rich in resources and fertility of soil.

"Ashland is the last town in Oregon as the tourist goes on his way to see the exhibition at San Francisco or is the first town as the tourist enters the state after having been to the fair.

"In order to get the building up in time for the fair the funds must be forthcoming now and the work of erecting the building must be started and completed before the meeting of the state legislature next year. Portland bankers will advance the money provided they can get the support of the state, and the assurance of the people that the state legislature will

reimburse them when it holds its session the first of next year.

"If your county and city are in favor of this thing let them send word of their co-operation and support to the big Boosters' meeting which will be held at Eugene, February 19, 1914."

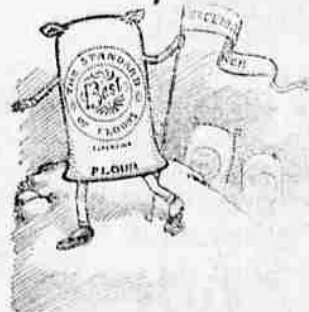
