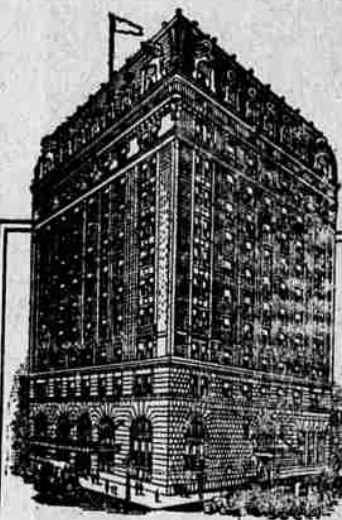
Call For Bids.
