## GRANGE ASKS FOR CHANGES

COTTAGE GROVE FARMERS OPPOSED TO TAX PLAN.

Want Old Method Readopted, Opposing the New as Harmful One.

Resolutions against the present system of tax collection were adopted at the meeting of Lane Pomona Grange of Cottage Grove, which met in special session Saturday. The resolution will be presented to the state grange. The object of the resolution is to return to the former manner of collection, whereby the tax could be paid in two equal semi-annual payments without penalty attaching on the second payment. The rebate of 3 per cent for payment of the full amount at the first payment period is not desired. The state grange will be asked to initiate a bill providing for this change.
