BARRETT ANNOUNCES PLATFORM



Hon. C. A. Barrett, Athena Man, who seeks re-nomination to the office of joint senator from Union, Umatilla and Morrow counties.

C. A. Barrett announces his candidacy for re-nomination on the republican ticket for joint senator for the 19th senatorial district, comprising the counties of Umatilla, Union and Morrow, to be voted for at the primary nominating election to be held on May 15, 1914. In submitting his candidacy to the voters of the district, he stands on his record in the House and Senate of the Oregon legislature during the past eight years.

Mr. Barrett is largely identified with the farming and commercial interest of the country, a resident of Umatilla county for 42 years, for 30 years interested in mercantile and banking in Athena. At the time the First National bank of Athena was organized he was one of the incorporators, and was elected the bank's first president,

which office he held for several years. After giving up the presidency he served the bank as director for some time, having been identified with the development of Umatilla county and the upbuilding of the state his interests are largely with the farming community, being a large land owner and heavy taxpayer, largely interested in the growing of wheat and alfalfa and stock raising, he knows the wants of the farmer.

His platform is economy and retrenchment, reforming our tax laws, reduction and consolidation of our several State Commissions. His complete platform is herewith published in full:

Declaration of Candidacy.

To the Hon. Ben W. Olcott, Secretary of the State of Oregon, to the members of the republican party, and the electors of Umatilla, Union and Morrow counties, comprising the 19th Senatorial District in the State of Oregon:

I, Charles A. Barrett, reside at Athena, Umatilla county, Oregon, and my post office address is Athena, Oregon. I am a duly registered member of the republican party. If I am nominated for the office of Senator for the 19th Senatorial District, State of Oregon, at the primary nominating election to be held in said Senatorial district and in the State of Oregon, on the 15th day of May, 1914, I will accept the nomination and not withdraw, and if I am elected I will qualify as such officer.

If nominated and elected I will during my term of office, support economy and retrenchment in state and county affairs; tax laws permitting one-half payment May 1st, one-half November 1st, without interest or penalty, and making County Treasurers collectors of delinquent taxes; amendment of Corrupt Practices Act to make it clear, reasonable and effective; statute prohibiting paid circulation of initiative petitions and providing that same be deposited for signature, with County Clerks and registration officers in various precincts; consolidation of public offices wherever possible; reduction of salaries of public officials wherever reasonable; such legislation as will insure law enforcement without recourse to martial law.

After my name on the nominating ballot I desire printed: Retrenchment; Less Appropriations; Fewer offices; Easy terms and times of tax payment.
