W. T. Salisbury, special representative of a Chicago bureau, passed through the city this morning on his way to Joseph where he will give one

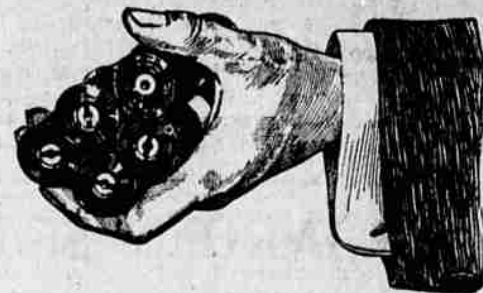
of his entertaining lectures on travel and adventure in connection with moving pictures.
