CLOSING ADDRESS.**

LUMBER JACKS FEAR WEAPON

**MANAGER GARDINIER OF
BAKER UNAFRAID.**

Drunk Crew Cowed and Made to Accept Paychecks from Manager.

Baker, March 28.—(Special)... When Frank Gardinier, general manager of the Baker White Pine Lumber company, told 33 drunken lumberjacks that he was armed and that he would stand for no foolishness the 33 decided that discretion was the better part of valor and retreated from their positions to attempt to inflict harm on the general manager Monday. Mr. Gardinier found no logs coming in from his camp Monday, and learning that something was wrong, hastened up to the camp near Austin and found things in bad shape. Five gallons of whisky had been taken into the camp. This whisky was procured at Austin Sunday and by Monday when Mr. Gardinier reached the scene he found virtually the entire camp in a state of uproar.

The men were belligerent. There was one royal rough and tumble fight, between William Baker and Ben Harrison, both being badly mangled by the encounter. Mr. Gardinier proceeded to discharge the majority of the unduly 33. They refused to be fired; they refused to accept time checks for their work and demanded the coin. There is where Mr. Gardinier let the men know he was "heeled" and he let them know how quickly he would act if the occasion arose. The men thereupon decided to accept the time checks and a new force was put to work.

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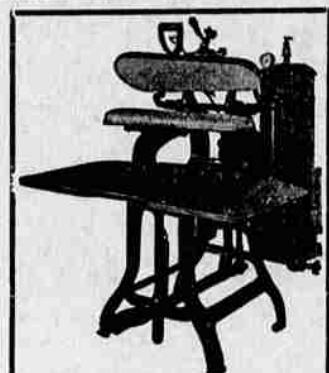
