SEWER PROJECT CONDUCTED ON NEW BASIS.

Taxpayers to Have Exact Cost in Hand Before Proceeding Further.

When the proposed Northside sewer district bounded by X on the North, North Depot on the East, North Fourth on the West and the railroad tracks on the South is assessed the city officials will know precisely what the project will cost, for bids will be called before the legal proceedings are taken. Except for the five-block sidewalk project now preliminarily under way, this is the first time that the city has conducted its business this way. Manager Lafky has pointed out to the taxpayers the need of knowing exactly what the project is going to cost, who the contractor will be, and all about it.

This project calls for extension of laterals now running West from Spruce street, and will put sewers in the heavily populated sections of the North Side.
