## JURY PROBING MILTON MORALS

CHARGES PREFERRED BY KILPACK AIRED.

Pendleton Grand Jury Takes Up Consideration of Charges.

Pendleton, April 14.—Investigation of the moral conditions at Milton and Freewater is under way today by the grand jury and it is expected that some indictments will be returned. The investigation follows the charges made by J. G. Kilpack, representative of the Boys' and Girls' Aid society of Portland, that many young men and girls in those communities have been indulging in riotous conduct and that conditions there are as bad or worse than at Copperfield.

Kilpack was himself a witness before the jury this morning and he was followed on the stand by the seventeen year old girl who was brought down from Milton several days ago and who, it is said, has made a con-

fession implicating a dozen well known young men. The girl, whose name is withheld, is not vicious by nature, according to Mr. Kilpack, but is only a victim of the deplorable conditions in the east end towns. She emerged from the grand jury room at noon with her eyes red and tearful.

Earl Frazier and Elmo Coe, the two young men arrested last week upon complaint of Kilpack, and four or five other girls are expected to arrive this afternoon to appear before the grand jury.

The grand jury is composed of the following seven men: Frank Frazier, foreman; Clark E. Nelson, clerk; M. G. McKern, W. T. Perrin, E. A. Dudley, Carl Jensen and E. H. Richmond.

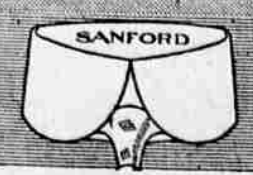

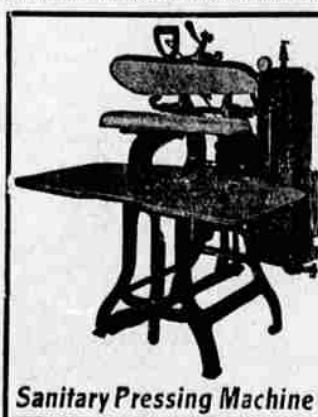
