END OF MONTH TO BE SUNDAY SCHOOL WEEK.

Men of Much Prominence Coming to La Grande April 29.

From April 27 until May 2, Sunday School workers of the entire state will be found in two cities of Oregon—Albany, from the 27 to the 29, and in La Grande from the 29 to May 2. State association chieftains aver that nothing has ever been attempted like it. A galaxy of speakers and Sunday School workers famed the entire country over, are to be at both places while the Twin-state conventions are going on. Such men as John L. Alexander, of Chicago, who is the noted "teen" specialist, I. E. Williamson, general secretary for British Columbia, E. C. Knapp, secretary for the Inland Empire association, Mrs. E. C. Knapp, elementary specialist of Spokane, Rev. R. D. Ousterhout, of the Idaho M. E. conference, Rev. Walton Skipworth D. D., Charles A. Phipps and many other special workers are slated to be at both conventions, the Cascades dividing the territory of the state. At La Grande, Jesse M. Jones of Pilot Rock will handle the special choirs and arrange for the soloists.

Free entertainment and lodging and breakfast is to be provided at each place, and those desiring reservation should notify Dr. H. S. Brown of La Grande for the La Grande convention.

In addition older boys and girls' conferences are to be held at both places, in La Grande on May 2-3, and J. H. Rudd, secretary of the Y. M. C. A., expects a big delegation of boys from Eastern Oregon to come here.
