KEEPING BUSY**

WEEKLY REPORT SHOWS NATURE OF WORK.

Fines Collected, Sewers Inspected,  
Water Department Busy.

General manager's report for week ending April 18th:

I beg to reply that the city treasurer collected \$77.50 water rent, \$110.00 for licenses, \$125.97 street assessment and interest and received \$20,483.17 for 1913 taxes from the county treasurer. Redeemed warrants with interest in the sum of \$22,383.24 and bought \$215.83 face warrants for B. C. P. L. Sinking fund for \$205.05 and entered meter readings.

The police collected \$5.00 fine, \$10.00 forfeit and has an assignment of balance of wage check which will net \$16 or \$17 on a \$25.00 fine.

The recorder received \$370.00 assessment on 56-B, 29.08 assessment on No. 60, \$45.48 sewer assessment and interest, \$5.00 fine \$10.00 forfeiture, \$34.00 dog tax, \$1.00 for two building permits. Issued two taxi and two dance hall licenses on treasurer receipt. Issued Imp. Dist. Interest warrant for \$150.00 and \$205.05 on B. C. P. L. Sinking fund to pay for warrants bought. Warrant for library expense \$26.12, also \$1,500 warrant on 10 percent final on Dist. No. 57.

Water superintendent spent \$16.24 on taps, \$23.70 cleaning reservoir, \$2.87 cleaning sewer, \$2.75 repairing and \$16.76 reading meters or a total of \$62.32 for the week.

The fire department had no calls. The Bowser Pump and storage tank has arrived and is now installed.

The engineer set grade stakes and inspected the subway sewer. Also grade and stakes for Mr. Wheelwright, Dr. Holt, 1304-6 and 1310 W Avenue, Mr. Patterson, Mr. Wheelwright, L. D. S. Church. Made survey and estimate for 2 blocks lateral sewer to be handled privately.

The 18 inch pipe on Hansen's property should be carried into N. Avenue and into sewer or catch basin. Established grades and wrote ordinances for grades on Penn. and Washington Ave., completed map of B. O. P. L. right of way in the Whitman Reserve.

Several calls for sewers in the district around the court house will require the construction of a trunk sewer from Washington on I Ave., to 8th street and a couple of blocks North and South or a total of 3000 ft., which the general fund has to pay.

I am making an index of all the ordinances of the city by subjects. This will enable anyone to find any ordinance on any subject without going over the index of 7 books. Later we will index only the live ordinances. Then legislation on any subject will be reduced to an exact and definite basis.

Many old ordinances should be revised to meet new conditions and the old ones repealed.

I have extended the leave of absence of the Chief of Police 15 days and will keep Mr. W. W. Randall until the Chief's return.
