EVIDENT THAT 1913 CROP WILL BE SOLD.

Apples Cleaned Up and Interest Centered on Holdover Spuds.

Apple crops are cleaned out. The 1913 output in this valley has been pretty well taken care of, and commission men are now cleaning up potatoes. There are some potatoes left, but sales are rapid and wholesalers are giving their attention to cleaning the valley of spuds. Fifty cents for the hand sorted stuff is the favorite quotation and several carload lots are being moved. If the present brisk movement in potatoes keeps up the 1913 crop will be well out of the way before new potatoes come in.
