FIRST FIRE IN 71 DAYS FAKE

TWO MILE RUN MADE BY DEPARTMENT LAST NIGHT.

Brush Pile Near Deal Canyon Dairy Cause of the Alarm.
The first fire alarm in 71 days was turned in last night from box 22. The

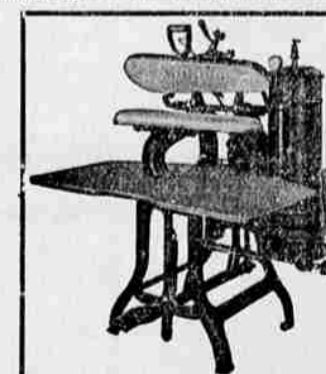
