Wool seems to be the greatest surprise of all marketable products of the west just now, and traders see no indication that it is going to come down appreciably, during the clipping season. In fact most of the crops have been contracted for at prices from three to five cents higher than for the same period last year.

The grain outlook is not so promising. Most all the markets and producing sections report the best kind of weather and good prospects. Northwest prices are not active and remain the same as two or three days ago. There seems to be little demand for wheat and the price in consequence is not inclined upward.

Hogs are holding their own, and cattle likewise, though the shipments are below normal. Sheep are showing weakest, and the offerings are not numerous. There is no violent change one way or the other, and the outlook in a general way is for good times throughout the entire northwest.
