The high school play, "All of a Sudden Peggy" given last Friday night by the students of the senior class, was a remarkable performance in many respects. The play has some difficult spots in it, and contains much real humor that must be brought out through appropriate gestures. But the entire cast seemed to have grasped the meaning of the plot and brought it out splendidly. Mildred Bush as Mrs. O'Mara was particularly good in her inimitable role, as was also Florence Happersett in the role of Peggy O'Mara. The widow O'Mara is bent on the marriage of Peggy, with Lord Anthony Crackenthorpe and comes near forcing through her will with the balking daughter Peggy. But Peggy has another scheme and finally elopes with Jimmy Keppel, sir Anthony's youngest brother, and falls in love with him, thereby putting to naught the vaulting ambition of her mother. The entire cast was strong and performed creditably. Lynne Bohnenkamp, as Lord Crackenthorpe, had the right "dontherknow" air and aided much to make the play humorous. Ray Couch, impersonating the Hon. Jas. Keppel, showed all the daring young spirit necessary to make him appear the part of a loving adventurer, and together with Miss Happersett in the role of Peggy brought a happy ending to an otherwise interesting, well acted and successful achievement by amateur performers.
