MILLMEN HEAR ACCIDENT LAW

TWO COMMISSIONERS EXPLAIN COMPENSATION ACT.

Chicago Editor Also Hear to Attend Meeting of Timbermen.

All the principal details of the new Workmen's compensation act which becomes effective shortly, were explained yesterday to a dozen or more members of the Eastern Oregon Lumber Producers association by Messrs Marshall and Mitchell, of the Oregon commission. The meeting was held here as the quarterly session of the association and while other matters came up, the compensation act was one of the chief matters discussed. The explanation and descriptions of the act were made by the commissioners in such a way that the millmen became familiar with the law.

Baker sent five timbermen, Wallowa one, and Union county mills were well represented. C. J. Austin, representing the American Lumberman, published at Chicago, was in attendance. President Geo. Stoddard presided, and the meeting was held in the La Grande National bank directors room.

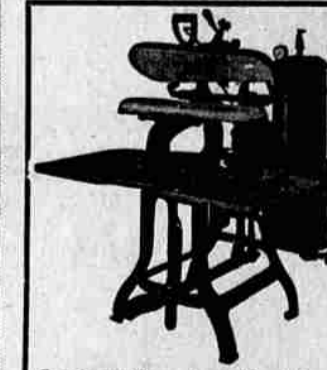
