Sheep Holding Steadily to Former Prices at Portland.

Portland Union Stockyards, May 14.—Extreme weakness is being shown in the hog market, and prices sagged another nickel this morning, making \$8.35 the top quotation. More than half of the morning's receipts were disposed of.

Cattle are a minus quantity. None were received at the yards yesterday or today, and there was very little call. When the hold-overs were disposed of yesterday, the yards were cleaned up. Reports received show that several shipments are en route here.
