CONVENTION DRAWS NEAR

PORTLAND MAGAZINE PREDICTS
BIG ATTENDANCE.

Small Cross-Road Merchant Appealed
to 100 Portlanders Due.

(From the Oregon Merchant's Magazine.)

The widespread interest in the La Grande Convention so enthusiastically exhibited through out the state has assumed a more definite tenor with the date of the annual meeting but a few weeks removed. General plans have been substituted by concrete arrangements having specified application of intelligent representation, vital trade reforms and partial recommendations.

Every local association within the state that has even a semblance of life will be represented at La Grande. This will be true also of several im-

portant towns yet unorganized but whose merchants realize the possibilities of education and benefit to be derived from a trade gathering of this character. Individual members from a wide area have written the state secretary asking information on rates, reservations and of accommodations at the convention city. It is the merchant of the small town and cross-roads, he who is denied frequent conferences with his brother merchant, who derives the greatest amount of benefit from the convention. During the year he drops unconsciously into a rut. He conducts his business along a groove, deepened and narrowed by habit. He needs ideas of new methods of economical devices and an assimilation of general merchandise hints. He wants the opportunity of enlisting his aid intelligently in the reforms and improvements outlined by his associates in business. He has valuable opinions himself and wants the opportunity of expressing them.

The coming convention is to be no congress of eloquence. Problems will be presented and discussed in every day common sense English. The greater number of merchants who

participate in the discussion, the greater will be the results achieved. All Factors Will Participate.

Although the greater portion of the attendance at the convention will be merchants, information indicates that the number of manufacturers, jobbers and salesmen who plan participation is very large. This is gratifying knowledge. The state association is founded on the basis of co-operation. This does not mean alone a co-operation limited to those who happen to be members but to all those whose interests are aligned with the retailer. All factors of the trade are warmly welcome to attend the convention and in addition their ideas and suggestions will be cordially received.

In La Grande meeting as indicated will be the largest gathering of merchants ever held in Oregon. Portland will send at least 100 delegates, Salem is to provide a car for 50 of its members, Albany, Roseburg, Medford, Marshfield, The Dalles, Hood River, Astoria and a score of other western Oregon towns are planning delegations, while eastern Oregon merchants will be present in unusual numbers.

Special rates will be granted on all railroads of a fare and one-third based on the certificate plan. Merchants who desire to join the Portland delegation may secure reservations by addressing the state secretary. This also applies to manufacturers, jobbers or salesmen who plan attendance.

June is a favorable month in eastern Oregon. All the beauty of the Grande Ronde Valley and the rugged scenery of the nearby mountains of La Grande is affording entertainment to those who abandon the irksome routine of business for a few days in favor of a vacation holding both profit and enjoyment.

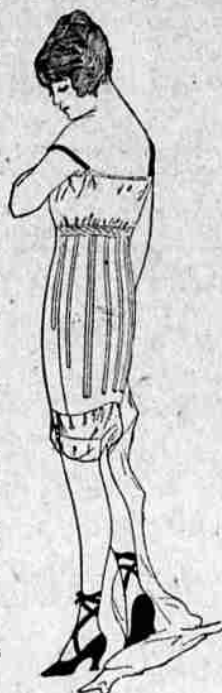
