## JAIL FOLLOW HIRING HORSE

C. W. FRANCE AND WIFE HIRE HORSE TO GO TO ELGIN.

Suspicion is Aroused and Parties Are Arrested and Brought Back.

C. W. France and his wife went to the St. Louis stables in La Grande and hired a horse, telling the liveryman that they intended to go to Elgin where they expected to transact business for four days. The horse was given them and they started out for that place. Instead of stopping at Elgin they drove on to Wallowa, where G. W. Kelly and Al Johnson recognized the horse and became suspicious. They immediately phoned to K. A. McCarthy, the proprietor of the barn and were told the facts of the case whereupon, they set legal machinery in motion and had the parties arrested. Sheriff Marvin deputized Mr. Kelly to bring the parties to La Grande, where they were turned over to the sheriff and lodged in jail. Wm Hannack of this city, left today for the horse and buggy which are valued at \$150. The preliminary hearing will be held today.

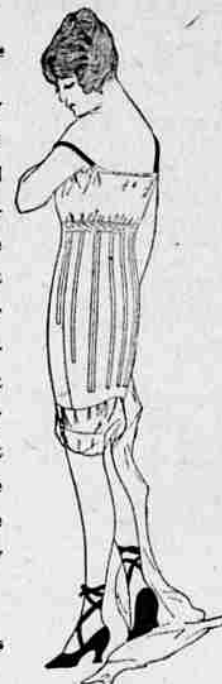
