Milton Berries Not of Best Quality—Head Lettuce is Gone.

Sunday dinners in La Grande can be touched off with excellent tomatoes grown in Union county. The Elgin hot house crop is now on sale in La Grande, and the offering is high grade, but nevertheless prices have not gone up over imported stuff—still 25 cents per pound. The home grown quality is much better than the foreign goods.

Berries, coming from Milton principally, are not of the very best sort yet, being a trifle green. This is particularly true of the larger berries, while the small varieties are riper and better quality in general. It is believed the Saturday shipments will bring a nicer lot than came today.

Head lettuce is no more, and hot house stuff commands 25 cents per pound.

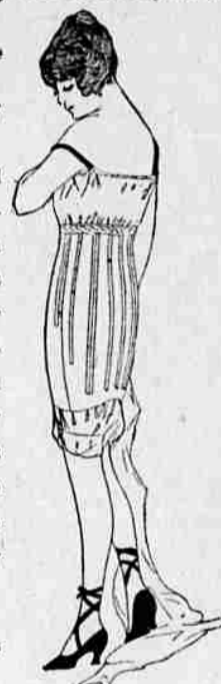
