CHOICE STUFF SELLS A LITTLE HIGHER NOW.

Variation Not Much But Difference is Upward at Portland.

Union Stockyards, Portland, June 16.—Cattle and hog prices picked up with the opening of the market this week and prime light steers are now selling at \$7.80 and hogs at \$8.05, a gain of a nickel for cattle and 20 cents for swine. The sheep market continued steady at unchanged prices.

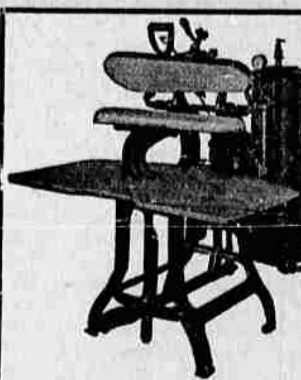
