LOGGING CREW GETS HOLIDAY

TWO HUNDRED MEN TO COME OUT FROM CAMP.

Special Cars Sent Out to Handle the Extra Traffic Tonight.

About 200 men employed at the Palmer logging camps, have been given a half-week holiday for the Fourth of July celebration. Last evening about 50 came out on the evening train from Vincent where they are working and today two extra coaches were sent out on the Joseph train to accommodate 175 workmen who are coming in this evening. Local Agent J. H. Keeney went out with the morning train and will sell tickets to avoid the confusion of paying cash fares as there is no ticket office at Vincent.

Many of the men will go to the various cities and towns nearby to spend the fourth and some will remain in La Grande.

Stubs Demanded by Commissioner.

Salem, June 30.—County clerks can be compelled by mandamus proceedings to turn over to the fish and game commission all unused fish and game licenses and the stubs of the licenses issued, so the commission can check the amount of money the clerks should turn into the fish and game fund, according to an opinion give today by Attorney General Crawford to State Game Warden Evans. Some of the clerks have refused to turn over such unused licenses and stubs on the ground that they are records of their office and should be kept in their office. The attorney general holds that the county clerks should keep their records in a book.

MANY RACERS TO RUN FRI.

ELGIN EXPECTS GOOD MOTOR-CYCLE RACES.

Baseball Program in Elgin Calls for Three Games.

Elgin, July 2.—(Special)—The entries in the motorcycle race have exceeded the hopes of the optimistic, for they are coming from all over this part of the country. A number of those who made the best records in the La Grande to Baker road race will be here, and they say that they are coming to show some speed. All the week the riders have been buzzing over the course that they will pursue Friday, and they say that the roads are in the best of shape. A number of them were under the impression that the race was on the 4th, but all have been informed, so far as is possible, that the machines will leave here at 10:00 on the morning of the 3rd.

The Baseball Games.

On the 5th the La Grande team will be here to play a regularly scheduled league game.

Episcopals to Select Bishop.

Portland, June 30.—To select a bishop to take the place of the late Bishop Charles Scadding, the standing committee of the Episcopal church of Oregon acting as the ecclesiastical authority and in accordance with Article VIII of the constitution, has called a special meeting of the convention of the diocese of Oregon, to be held in Trinity church and Parish House, Portland, September 16.

The official call is as follows:

"The standing committee of the diocese of Oregon, acting as the ecclesiastical authority thereof, and in accordance with the provisions of Article VI and Article XII of the constitution of said diocese, hereby does call a special meeting of the convention of said diocese, to be held in Trinity church and Parish House, in the City of Portland, on Wednesday, the 16th day of September, 1914, at 10 o'clock on said day.

"The purpose of said meeting shall be the selection of a bishop and the transaction of such other business relating thereto as, in the judgment of the convention, shall be necessary and desirable."
