Sugar Misses Day in Upward Climb—Another Raise Expected.

Following on the heels of Saturday's announcement that Portland mills had advanced the price of flour 20 to 40 cents a barrel, local mills boosted

the price of the product this morning, five cents a sack.  
Sugar which had formed a habit of hiking after three days of consecutive boosts in the price has missed a day, but another raise in the price is altogether probable.
