"Y" DIRECTORS HOLD MEETING

At the regular monthly board meeting of the Y. M. C. A. directors last night many matters of importance were discussed. Because of the volume of business and the fact that some matters required more time for consideration the board at a late hour adjourned to meet again next Monday night. The report of the general secretary, among other statistics and figures, showed that in the 20 held each week the attendance for the month was 1062. The attendance in the building for the month was 4000. His report showed that the average attendance to the four Sunday afternoon meetings held during the month was 52. The collections during the

month on building fund and furniture fund together totaled \$529.35. All recommendations of the Secretary were discussed but only one received final action. This was the authorizing of a finance committee to approve all bills of the association before payment is made and to secure interest bearing notes from all delinquent fund subscribers. The recommendation that vacant lot adjoining the building be converted into a tennis court was discussed but final action postponed until Monday night.

T. M. Baird, president of the Baker Y. M. C. A. is in the city, a delegate to the Grande Ronde Presbytery. After a trip through the local Association building he had this splendid compliment to pay to all who have had a part in its erection. "I have never seen a Y. M. C. A. in a city of this size with a building better planned to meet the demands of the men and boys of the entire community than your structure. Everyone who has helped in the making possible of this building should be justly proud of his work. I am glad to learn that your board has adopted a system of economy in the operation of the building. This will save them much time and trouble later on. I hope that the association may continue to make its steady progress."

Dallas, Tex., April 15.—The quarantine against the world adopted a few months ago by Texas to protect this state from the introduction of the foot and mouth disease was slackened partly today. Interchange of cattle without quarantine restrictions was permitted between Texas, Arizona, New Mexico and Colorado, in accordance with an agreement entered into by representatives of these states at the recent American Live Stock association convention in San Francisco.
