New York, May 2. —Cooled by the evening breezes New York's open air movies are running full bloom and thousands are crowding the roofless Motion Picture theatres nightly. Managers agree that the open air theatres were late in getting a start this year. They attribute this to the extremely late spring. Up to a few nights ago the weather has been so unreasonable that not an open air movie attempted to begin business.

But now every avenue and almost every side street has a movie garden. Open lots have been idle for years have been transformed into screen palaces and from the number of new ones now open in comparison with those of last summer it bids fair to be a record season for the movie owners.

Many new theatres have been added this season. Chief among the improvements in Manhattan's movie gardens is the special care taken of

the children. Couples with young children, who cannot be left at home alone, now find special runways within the movie garden where they can safely leave their baby carriages.

Not a few of the open air movies now provide cushions for the otherwise hard benches and ice water is served during the intermissions just like the regular Broadway theatres. Some even have printed programs, for the patrons of the movies are now as exacting as those of the biggest legitimate show houses.

Another novel feature is provided for doctors and others who expect to be called away from the performance. All that is necessary is for the person to leave his name with the box office and should a call come for him his name is flashed on the screen. Movie managers appreciate the value of such attention to their Patron's wants and they are always seeking to improve the movie performance.
