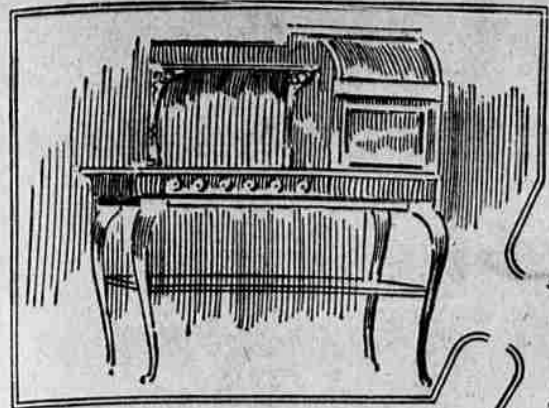

TWO CENTS CLIPPED OFF RECENTLY.

Gooseberries Sell by the Gallon, Which Means Less Money.

New potatoes are still going down, having dropped two cents since Friday and are now selling at eight cents. Peas are two and one-half cents cheaper and are bring 10c per pound. Gooseberries are now selling at 35c per pound. Milton strawberries and spinach are out of the market entirely.
