Gold Medal Flour up Twenty-Five Cents a Barrel.

Peas have dropped four cents since Tuesday and are now selling at four pounds for a quarter. Gold medal flour is selling at \$2.75, a raise of 25c. These are the only changes in the market this week. Following are the quotations as they now stand:

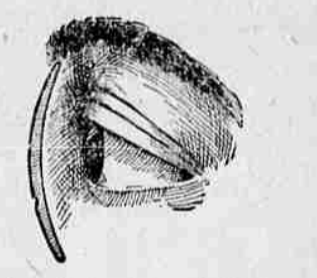
