JUNIOR CLASSES FEATURE

CHILDREN TO HAVE CHAUTAUQUA BY THEMSELVES.

Morning Lectures, Games and Songs a Big Undertaking.

"The junior chautauqua held in conjunction with the regular entertainments during chautauqua week is one of the greatest assets any town may acquire," recently stated one of the leading educational authorities in the state of California after attending morning session of the children's work at Palo Alto. "It is for the benefit of the children. We must come to the vital realization that the future of the nation depends upon the child of today. The junior chautauqua buds up the moral and physical life of the growing child. It is a powerful moulder of expanding childhood. It should be fostered and supported by every conscientious woman and man in the United States."

This branch of training, secured only through the junior chautauqua is practically a new addition to the great American assembly. The children congregate each morning and afternoon of the chautauqua. Expert teachers, trained in special schools for this purpose, care for the youngsters. Games are played, stories told and kindred episodes are introduced in rapid succession. The growing child is given an insight into the biggest things of life that are essential.

The teachers are sympathetic. Acquainted with the lives of children they are in a position to stimulate them to action along the right lines. The building of the instincts marks a definite period in the life of the child. The junior chautauqua directors are versed in these matters. They are aware of the many phases of emotional and social progression. Because of this, they are in a position to give the child the correct attention at the proper time.

They do not kill the instincts that seem detrimental. Neither do they allow them to run wild. Their duty is to guide and direct these fiery attitudes along the right channels. No games are introduced that have not a definite purpose. The children are amused, but at the same time they are being led through the many phases of life as it really is and should be. The methods by which this is done are above reproach and criticism.

The instructor who is to have charge of the children's work in La Grande next week will arrive here shortly.
