felt they could afford the expense. "To my mind there is only one satisfactory way to build a permanent hard surface road such as the Columbia highway, and that is for the state to do it. And this conclusion is arrived at after due and mature deliberation. I believe we should elect men to the state legislature regardless of political party or creed who will go to Salem and work untiringly for such a measure."

Others Approve Phy Plan.

When the county court was visited by a committee of taxpayers recently asking for an increased tax levy Judge Phy then in a brief way outlined his plan for permanent roads. It is noticeable that a number of those who called on the court, after thinking the Phy plan over have come out squarely in favor of it and are now advocating its adoption.
