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GRAND FINISH OF RACE HERE

THREE TEAMS LIKELY TO BE BUNCHED TONIGHT.

Race So Close That Outcome Is Much in Doubt.

SUGAR BEET WORK HALTS

Medford Quits Acreage Campaign to Obtain Factory.

Medford, Ore. Dec. 8.—"The talk about the beet sugar factory being located in Grants Pass is all bosh," said Alex Nibley, secretary of the Oregon-Utah Sugar Beet Company, today, following an ultimatum from the local beet sugar committee that they would do no more work until the assurance

was given that the district obtaining the large acreage would get the factory.

"We intend to carry out our original promise," said Mr. Nibley, "and place the factory in the center of the acreage, but the exact location will not be decided upon until February.

In spite of this statement, the local committee has given up the campaign for the present.

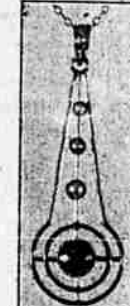
