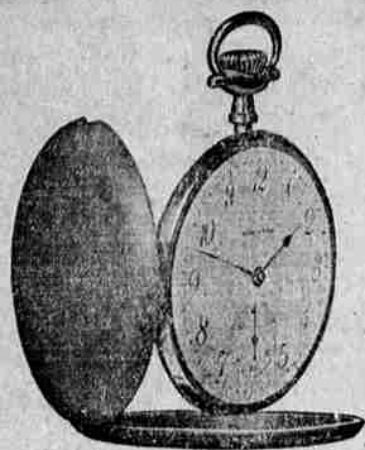

PROCLAMATION.

Be it Known to All Concerned that: Whereas, there was filed in the office of the Recorder of the City of La Grande, in Union County, Oregon, on the 6th day of October, A. D., 1915, an initiative petition signed by the requisite number of legal voters of and within said city, presenting for submission to the legal voters of said City for their adoption or rejection at the next regular general city election to be held in said city of La Grande, Oregon, on the 13th day of December, A. D., 1915, an act entitled "An Act Amending the Charter of the City of La Grande in Union County, Oregon," and setting out in full therein the Charter of said City as proposed to be amended, and

Whereas, the said act, and amendment of said charter as proposed by said petition was on the 6th day of October, A. D., 1915, duly and regularly adopted by the commission of the said city of La Grande, Oregon, at a regular meeting thereof, and said act and amendment was by said commission ordered submitted to the legal voters of said city at the said regular general election in said city on December 13, 1915, for their adoption or rejection, and

Whereas, the said act and amendment of the charter of said city of La Grande, Oregon, was on the said 13th day of December, A. D., 1915, at the regular general city election in said city held on said date duly and regularly submitted to the legal voters of said city, by them to be voted upon for adoption or rejection; and

Whereas, after said election, the ballots at said election were on the 16th day of December, 1915, duly and regularly canvassed and counted in the presence of the president of said city.

Now therefore, I, J. A. Russell, president of the city of La Grande in Union County, Oregon, do hereby declare and proclaim that at said election held in the city of La Grande, in Union County, Oregon, on the 13th day of December, 1915, there was cast by the legal voters of said city upon the question of the adoption or rejection of the said proposed act entitled "An Act to Amend the Charter of the City of La Grande, in Union County, Oregon, the total number of 1227 votes; 765 of said votes being cast in favor of the adoption of said act and amendment and 462 against the adoption of said act and amendment and that a majority vote of 303 ballots was cast for the adoption of said act and amendment and I hereby declare and proclaim that the said act entitled "An Act to Amend the Charter of the City of La Grande, in Union County, Oregon," was duly and regularly passed and adopted and that the same, together with the said amendment of said charter is in full force and effect.
