FOOTBALL PLAYED AS MUCH THERE AS HERE.

Caldwell Mentor, Recently of the South, Praises Nativity.

Football is as much a national game, and is played as extensively—and as well—throughout Oklahoma and other near-Southern states as in the west and north, according to Otto Neal, Caldwell high school principal and coach who has spent a few days in La Grande, returning home this morning. Neal is the man who engineered the team that cleaned up everything in Southern Idaho, including Boise, Pocatello, technical, Weiser, Payette and other teams. Baker defeated Caldwell seven to six and Washington high of Portland hung a defeat on them, otherwise their record was clear.

"Every school of any size or type in Oklahoma has a football team," said Mr. Neal in speaking of his native state. "Not only is football largely followed, but some fine players are developed, and our state university has defeated all nearby state universities except Nebraska, of late, and that wonderful team was given a mighty hard rub. Then too, track work is well advanced, each county having meets in a way similar to the northern and western states. Baseball is advanced there as far as it has her, and on the whole all lines of sport are followed out in the South. When one goes farther South, Mississippi or some South border states, football and other lines of sports deteriorate, but in Oklahoma they are at a high level.

"I would much liked to have had a game scheduled between Caldwell and La Grande this year, and hope that next year the two teams will meet."
