Agness Leslie went to Joseph this morning to spend New Year's day with her mother.

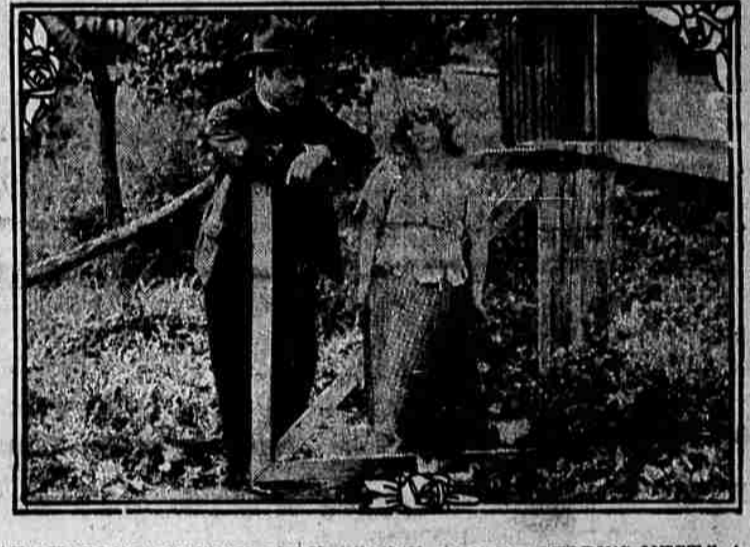
