PRECINCTS IN COUNTY CHANGE

MANY IMPORTANT ADDITIONS MADE BY COURT.

Complete Boundaries of All Precincts Changed Lately.

Several precincts of the county have been changed by the county court to conform with the new law. For the benefit of those who live in the changed precincts, the Observer herewith gives the official boundaries of such precincts as have been changed:

Alice Precinct

Commencing at the northeast corner of Sec. 28 Tp. 1 S R 41 on the boundary line between Union and Wallowa Counties, thence west 9 miles to the northwest corner of Sec. 30, Tp. 1 S R 40 E W M thence south 1 mile to the southeast corner of Sec. 25, Tp. 1 S R 39 E W M thence west 6 miles, north 1 mile, west 1 mile to the northwest corner of Sec. 25, Tp. 1 S R 38 E W M thence south 2 miles to the southwest corner of Sec. 36, Tp. 1 S R E W M thence west 2 miles to the southwest corner of Sec. 34 said township and range, thence south 2 miles to the southwest corner of Sec. 10, Tp. 2 S R 38 E W M, thence east 2 miles to the southeast corner of Sec. 11, Tp. 2 S R 38, thence south 2 miles to the southwest corner of Sec. 24, said township and range thence east 5 1-2 miles to the southeast corner of the SW 1-4 of Sec. 23, Tp. 2 S R 39 E W M, thence north 1 mile to the northeast corner of the NW 1-4 of said Sec. 23, thence due east to the southeast corner of Sec. 15, Tp. 2 S R 41 E W M thence following the boundary line between Union and Wallowa Counties to the place of beginning.

Cove Precinct No. 1.

Commencing at a point on the boundary line between Union and Wallowa Counties at the northeast corner of the SE 1-4 of the NW 1-4 of Sec. 16, Tp. 3 S R. 42, E W M., thence west 11 3-4 miles to the southeast corner of the NW 1-4 of the NW 1-4 of Sec. 15, Tp. 3 S R 40 East, thence south 3-4 mile to the southeast corner of the SW 1-4 of the SW 1-4 of said Sec. 15 thence east 3 3-4 miles to the northwest corner of Sec. 19, thence south 2 miles to the southwest corner of Sec. 30, thence east 2 miles to the northeast corner of Sec. 32, thence south 1 mile to the southeast corner of said Sec. 32, all in Tp. 3 S R 40 East, thence east 15 miles to the boundary line between Union and Wallowa Counties, thence following said boundary line in a northerly direction to the place of beginning.

Elgin Precinct No 1

Commencing at a point in the center of the intersection of Front Street with "C" Street in the City of Elgin, Union County, Oregon, thence west about 5 blocks, thence north 1 block, to the county road, thence west on said county road to the city limits of the City of Elgin, thence following said county road in a general westerly direction to Phillips Creek, thence along the center of said Phillips Creek in a westerly direction to whereas said Phillips Creek crosses the range line between ranges 38 and 39, thence north along said range line about 8 1-4 miles to the northeast corner of Sec. 6, Tp. 2 N R 39 E W M, thence west 3 1-2 miles to the boundary line between Union and Umatilla counties thence following said boundary line in a northerly direction to the boundary line between Union and Wallowa counties, thence east about 11 miles on said boundary line to the northeast corner of Sec. 1 Tp. 4 N R 40 E W M thence south on said boundary line to the junction of the Grande Ronde River with the Wallowa river thence up the center of said Grande Ronde River in a southwesterly direction to Front Street in the City of Elgin, thence following said Front Street to place of beginning.

Elgin Precinct No 2

Commencing at a point in the center of the intersection of Front Street with "C" Street in the City of Elgin, Union County Oregon, thence west about 5 blocks, thence north 1 block to the county road, thence west on said county road to the city limits of said City of Elgin, thence following said county road in a general westerly direction to Phillips Creek, thence along the center of said Phillips Creek in a westerly direction to whereas said Phillips Creek crosses the range line between ranges 38 and 39, thence south about 4 miles to the southwest corner of Sec. 31 Tp. 1 N R 39 E W M thence east 1 1-2 miles, thence north 1-2 mile to center of Sec. 32, thence east one mile to center of Sec. 33, thence south 1-2 mile to the southwest corner of the SE 1-4 of Sec. 33, all in Tp. 1 N. R. 39, E W M., thence east to the center of the Grande Ronde River, thence along said river in a northerly direction to the city limits of said City of Elgin, thence west to Union Street, thence north to the point of beginning.

Elgin Precinct No 3.

Commencing at a point in the center of the intersection of Front Street with "C" Street in the City of Elgin, Union County Oregon, thence north on said Front Street to the center of the Grande Ronde River, thence following said Grande Ronde River in a northerly and easterly direction to the boundary line between Union and Wallowa Counties, thence south on said boundary line to where it intersects the county road leading from Elgin to Wallowa county at the northeast corner of Sec. 36, Tp. 2 N R 40 E W M., thence following said county road in a general southeasterly direction to where said county road intersects "C" Street in said City of Elgin, thence west on said "C" Street to place of beginning.
