**WANT ATTORNEY SUSPENDED.**

Serious Charge Placed Against Lawyer of Baker.

Baker, Jan. 21.—Alleging that Paul C. Dormitzer, acquitted during the last term of circuit court on the charge of obtaining money under false pretenses, is bringing the practice of law in Baker county into disrepute through disregard of the ethics of the profession, District Attorney Godwin filed this morning a petition with Circuit Judge Anderson asking that Dormitzer's privilege of practicing law be suspended.

Specific charges of passing worthless checks, debauchery, attempting to intimidate city officials into giving up prisoners, coaching prisoners in the county jail to testify falsely and encouraging litigation, are made in the petition.

"It seems to me that this man has violated his oath as an attorney, in which even the public should be protected," Mr. Godwin said this morning. "The proceedings will clear the matter up."

Mr. Godwin asserted that he filed the petition, not in his capacity as district attorney but as a private practitioner.
