Loesser, Baker, Rev. J. F. Costello, Portland. The minor offices were performed by the altar boys of the church.

The music was rendered by the children's choir. At the offertory, the Ave Maria was sung by Miss Eileen Peare and Miss Mary Newlin. The music was of high order of excellence.

Immediately after the gospel, Father Driscoll made the announcements, and expressed his thanks to those present for the assistance and encouragement rendered by them.

The Right Reverend Bishop O'Reilly then delivered a forceful and stirring sermon, taking for his text the introit of the mass of dedication. In stirring words he explained to those present the meaning of the word "church," the holiness attached to the term, the respect that Christians should have for the house of God, and the necessity of coming there to worship him.

The Church of Our Lady of the Valley is one of the architectural gems of Eastern Oregon. Built in the modified Norman-Gothic style, of terracotta and pressed brick, it is regarded as the pride of the city of La Grande by Catholics and non-Catholics alike. The interior decorations are in keeping with the Gothic style of architecture. The altars, chancel railing, pews, stations and windows being harmonious in design. The stained glass windows attracted attention of all present. These windows represent scriptural subjects in beautiful colorings. They are the gifts of various members of the parish.

Degrees Exemplified. In the afternoon the visiting Knights of Columbus united with the La Grande council in the exemplification of the three degrees of Columbianism. The Baker council exemplified the first degree, La Grande council the second degree, and the Pendleton council, under the direction of District Deputy J. H. Peare, exemplified the third degree to a class of fifty-two candidates.

In the evening a sumptuous banquet was served to two hundred Knights and visiting priests. The guest of honor was the Right Reverend Bishop. When he entered the hall, the Knights rose in a body and gave him a rousing welcome. At the main table the bishop and clergymen were seated, together with the City
