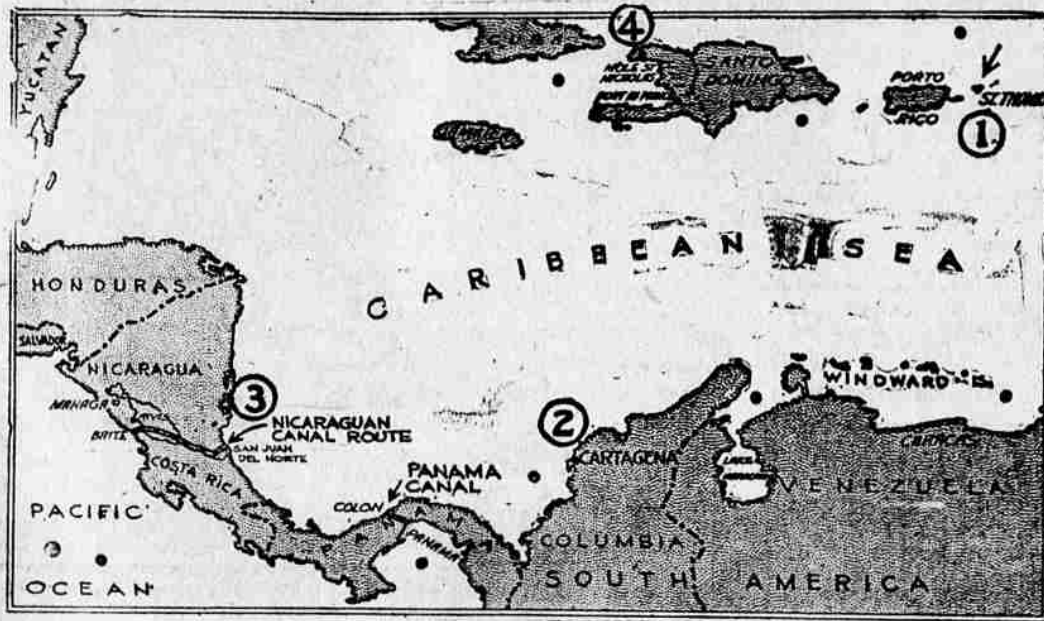

HOW GERMANS SOUGHT CONTROL OF CARIBBEAN SEA.

New York, Feb. 22.—Evidence has just been produced before the Foreign Relations Committee of the United States Senate that before the war in Europe Germany planned naval bases which might have given her control of the Caribbean Sea, at least enabled her to dispute control with the United States. It is said the Hamburg-American line has leased from Denmark a large area of ground at St. Thomas, which could be used as a naval base. Other evidence shows another attempt was made to lease from Columbia a base at Cartagena. But the most interesting evidence is that which was declared to be an attempt to buy the Nicaragua Canal route at a cost of \$9,000,000. The United States offers only \$3,000,000. To complete the circle of the Caribbean, they attempted to buy a base at the Mole St. Nicholas in Haiti.
