In addition to this contest there is one for younger boys called a Standard of Efficiency test. It is made up of religious, physical and educational branches. These are framed so that no gymnasium is necessary and can be successful throughout in rural and urban districts alike. V. K. Hall, president of the Oregon Sunday School association, and H. C. Ballridge president of the Idaho association, are giving a cup for this contest. The international committee has prepared a plan of action for competitors in this test that is absolutely fair to all regardless of facilities, and these may be had at the same address that the older boys information is available.

"We have here some tests that will reach, or should reach, to the remotest parts of the two states" said Mr. Rudd in speaking of the movement while in La Grande yesterday. "It is entirely harmonious with all existing clubs, simply enlarging the scope and giving added increase in effectiveness. In all matters the boy on the farm has the same facility as the boy in town and visa versa, for, example, the study of agriculture may be applied equally well in either a back yard or on a big farm. We are indeed anxious that as many as possible enter. All that is necessary is for some Sunday school class, Boys' club, or similar institution to elect one man to attend to the correspondence and by getting in touch with me, can learn all the rules and regulations and we will help him get started and see that each class is kept going. We deem this the biggest thing ever tried in the way of interesting boys in uplifting pursuits of health, happiness and money."

GREAT TESTS GIVEN YOUNG

IDAHO AND OREGON Y. M. C. A. MEN BUSY.

John H. Rudd at Head of Comprehensive Campaign of Education.

One of the most comprehensive contests for older boys and young boys that has yet been devised by Y. M. C. A. workers, is now being put into working shape for the coming summer—beginning April 1st and ending November 1st. John H.

Rudd, formerly of La Grande, is at the head of it, under direction of the Y. M. C. A. bureaus of Oregon and Idaho. For the older boys, arrangements for a five-cornered contest have been made, and cups will be given to the winners in each of these departments which are: Bible study, along lines prepared by State Superintendent J. A. Churchill and obtainable from Y. M. C. A. headquarters; Thrift, intended to teach boys to make and save money; Agriculture, in connection with the already established Boys' clubs under O. A. C. and state supervision; Percentage of attendance, which keeps up interest, and lastly, membership increase. All Sunday school, Y. M. C. A.
