TWO BOYS HANGED.

California Prisons Scene of Hanging to Expiate Murder.

Sacramento, March 3.—Glenn Witt, aged 20, was hanged at Folsom at 10 o'clock this morning for the murder of William Alexander of Los Angeles. A few minutes later Charles Oxnam, aged 19, was hanged at San Quentin for the same crime.

Defunct Bank Asks for New Hearing

Salem, Ore., March 2.—Petitions for rehearing are to be filed by both the plaintiffs and defendants in the case of S. G. Sargent, superintendent of banks, against the defunct American Bank & Trust company of Portland. This suit was brought to recover a judgment for \$50,000, and the supreme court decided in favor of the plaintiff in the first cause of action calling for a judgment of \$53,000, and against it in the second calling for \$15,000. The defendants will file a petition for rehearing as to the first cause of action, and the plaintiff as to the last.

Bear Steaks Provided for Booster Banquet.

North Yakima, Wash., March 2.—Bear meat will be the piece de resistance at the booster banquet to be given by the Yakima Improvement club March 7, when officers and members of all the commercial organizations of the valley, from Kennewick to Ellensburg will be represented. Special trains have been promised and at least 500 visitors are expected. The entertainment committee is not depending upon a hunter for the bear meat, having bought one of the Sumack park animals, and the meat is already on the hook.

Huge Vein of Phosphorus Discovered

Rio De Janeiro, March 3.—A huge vein of phosphorus has been discovered near the mouth of the river Estrella, which empties into the bay of Rio de Janeiro near this city. The deposit has been taken by the Department of Agriculture and will be mined as a government property.

Says Mosquito Carries Leprosy
Rio De Janeiro, March 3.—The mosquito is the most hated citizen of Brazil. The largest charge lodged against him is that of carrying and transmitting leprosy. Dr. Bezaupaire de Aragao made the charge today and declared he proved it in several specific instances in his studies in the government leper colonies. It

Baker, March 1.—Working in conjunction with City school Superintendent A. C. Strange, Miss Helen Cowgill of the extension department of the Oregon Agricultural college, will spend Thursday and Friday in Baker, organizing industrial clubs among the children of the public schools.

A variety of specialties, including sewing, gardening and poultry and swine raising, will be offered the children, and an endeavor will be made to interest the parents in the movement. "Most of the best work along industrial training should be done during the summer months," Mr. Strange explained, and the cooperation of the fathers and mothers is necessary for this.

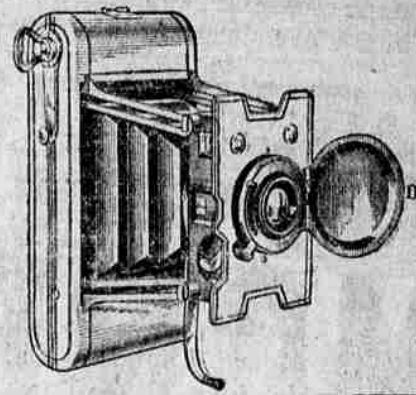
